FRONT ARM REAR BUSH

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Contents (parts per pack):

- 2 x Polyurethane A Bushes
- 2 x Polyurethane B Bushes
- 1 x PTFE/Silicone Grease

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual.

It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- -All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.



Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Remove the front wishbone from the vehicle. This will require the arm to be removed from the rubber bush that will remain in the bush console.
- 2. Leaving the console bolted to the subframe, completely remove the original bush by cutting it out or using a puller.
- 3. Clean away any dirt and corrosion from the console and wishbone, using a rounded file to remove any sharp edges to prevent damaging the new bush.
- 4. Press the larger B Bush into the console using either a puller in reverse or clamps.

Tip: To make the fitting of the larger B Bush easier, apply some washing up liquid onto the chamfered lip, and press with the bush at a slight angle.

- 5. Push the smaller A Bush onto the hexagonal pin of the wishbone.
- 6. Apply some of the supplied grease to the bore of the larger B Bush and the outside of the smaller A Bush.
- 7. Refit the arm onto the car, and tension all hardware to the manufacturer's recommended torque settings.
